

Summerworks Program Description

The Carolina Ballet Theatre's Summer Works program is a dance intensive that will run from June 25 to July 13 in Greenville, South Carolina.

Class Schedule

Summer Works classes will run from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Monday through Friday with one hour and fifteen minutes break for lunch.

Saturday classes will go from 9:00 AM until 2:00 PM. There is no class on Sunday.

Dancers are free to go shopping at the mall, eat out, go to movies and go to any of the art events available in the Greater Greenville area.

In the morning sessions, Summer Works instructors will cover a variety of relevant subjects. Sessions will include classes on dance styles (Ballet Technique, pointe, Jazz, Modern), ballet theatre study (Character, Drama) and other day today issues of the preprofessional dancer (Choreography, Pilates/conditioning/strengthening, Nutrition).

The afternoon sessions will consist of classes, choreography and rehearsal for the Summer Works Performance, to be performed July 11th at the Mc Alister auditorium at the Furman University. The Summer Works Performance will include classical and innovative works.

Accommodations

- Housing will be provided by Hampton Inn and host homes.
- CBT chaperones will be provided for all students.
- Students will be transported the few miles from the hotel to the CBT studio by a chartered bus. The bus will not travel on the interstate.
- Host homes will be limited and younger students will have priority.
- Parent accommodations are also available at the Hampton Inn (these accommodations need to be made early if parents plan to attend performance and pick up dancers on July 12 and 13th).

Meals

- Breakfast is served everyday at the Hampton Inn.
- Lunch and snacks will be served at the studio during the day.
- Dinners will be brought in to the Hampton Inn except for Saturday and Sunday. A Saturday dinner can be arranged for a nominal charge.
- Dancers will be able to go to surrounding restaurants and the mall close by for meals not covered by CBT Summer Works.

Important Dates

Sunday, June 24th all students will need to arrive at the Greenville Airport or the SCBT Studio between 2 to 5 PM

if a dancer has to come in the Charlotte airport, there will be a pickup fee of \$60.00 and they must arrive before 5:00 p.m.

Friday, July 13th The same goes for return trip. If anyone needs to make a special arrangement they will need to call the CBT office 864 297-1635 before they complete their reservation to make sure their arrival time or departure time fits the CBT Schedule.

Thursday, July 11th The Summer Works performance will be presented at the Mc Alister auditorium at the Furman University at 6:00 p.m. Tickets may be purchased through ticketmaster webpage

Support

- Transportation, chaperones, and event schedules to choose from will be provided.
- A fifteen passenger bus will be utilized for hotel dancers for three weeks.
- All students need to have a phone card or cell phone to call home.
- There will be schedule and transportation for dancers to attend the church of their choice on Sunday, if they so desire.

Tuition

- The Summer Works tuition is \$1000 and the Summer Works Housing will be \$1000. Very limited tuition scholarships are available.
